The Poetics and Linguistics Association (PALA) and the University of Maribor invite you to the PALA Annual Conference 2014 entitled:

## Everybody's Got Style! Testing the Boundaries of Contemporary Stylistics

Over the years, stylistics has explored various venues in search of the best methods and tools for analyzing style. By doing so, it has crossed boundaries with many other disciplines dedicated to the study of language, such as discourse analysis, pragmatics or narratology. More recently, stylistic analyses have been heavily influenced by the rapid development of information technology, most notably so in the domains of corpus studies and text-processing. The influence has not been unidirectional. On the contrary, many analytical methods and tools from stylistics have crossed into and found successful application in other disciplines including language teaching, media and translation studies, and others. This intense and continuous interrelationship between stylistics and other disciplines raises numerous questions: What are the boundaries of stylistics? Where does it end and other disciplines begin (or vice versa)? What are the benefits of interdisciplinarity, or its downsides, if any? Should stylistics be more territorial? What new areas should it explore?

These and similar questions will be addressed on **16-20 July 2014** at the **University of Maribor, Slovenia**, at the PALA annual conference.
